« Global Reporting Initiative G4 » in France, to be held November 27**

The TF1 Group will host on November 27th the launch in France of the new version of the non-financial reporting framework, GRI G4.

The event, organized by the GRI in collaboration with the United Nations Global Compact, will allow 150 participants (governmental stakeholders, companies, rating agencies, standardizing bodies, universities, etc...) to discover the main features of new repository in French, attend panel discussions and exchange views with their counterparts. An overview of non-financial reporting in France and worldwide will also be presented.
